

What is a Secondary Plan?


- A Secondary Plan is a land use policy plan for a district or large neighbourhood in a municipality which provides more detailed planning objectives and policies than those found in the municipal official plan.
- Secondary Plans can be for partially developed or undeveloped areas

What is an MESP?

- What is an MESP?
 - Integrated approach coordinates the requirements of both the *Environmental* Assessment and the *Planning Act*
 - Allows us to better examine the combined impacts of alternatives, leading to the development of other options and better solutions


Study Area


- Approx 520 ha
