	Stephen Robinson advised that the owner of 154 Ontario St has applied for a consent and variances that would require the demolition of the subject building. The house is on the Couling Inventory but is not listed on the Municipal Register. The Committee reviewed photos taken by Stephen at a recent site visit of the exterior of the house. Stephen added that he has not done an interior site visit. Stephen advised that he has no concerns with the demolition of the house. Lorraine Pagnan provided some historical information about the property. Lorraine noted that it was a grocery store until the 1940's and was the City's only vehicle licensing office from the 1940's – 1970's. Committee members requested that an interior site visit be done and to have a scoped heritage assessment done to confirm the historical/associative value of the property.
