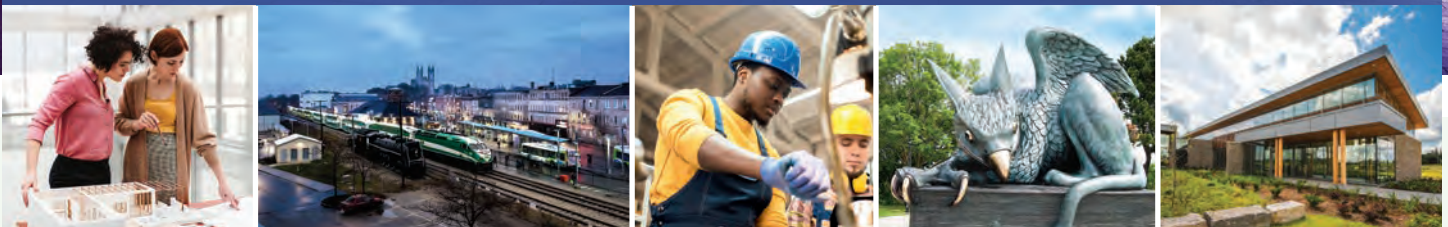


Your Unique Guelph
